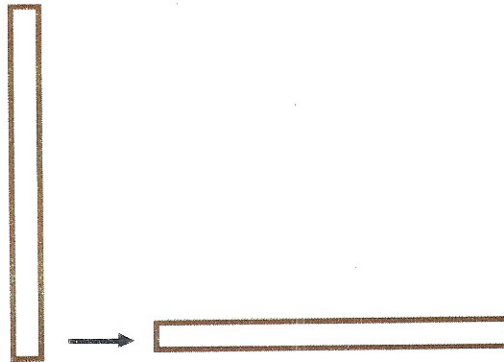


1. Cut 5 squares of cardboard, each piece measuring 2.5 inches by 2.5 inches
2. Run glue around the sides of one square, and stick the other four squares to the side, building walls.



3. For the lid, cut one square piece that measures 2.75 inches by 2.75 inches. Then cut out four rectangles that are 2.75 inches long and 1 inch wide.
4. Repeat step number four, but on the lid.
5. When your glue dries, place the lid onto the box and then draw a line around the seam where the lid meets the base.

To decorate:

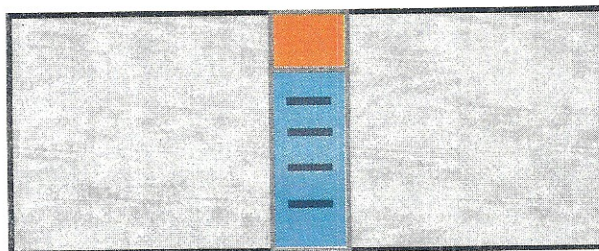
1. Paint one piece of foam sheet grey in color.
2. Paint another sheet white.

Cut four pieces of blue sheet - each piece should be the length of each of your base walls, but the width should not be greater than where you've drawn the line from step five. Glue the blue foam to each base wall.

Next,, cut four pieces of your grey foam. They should be the same height as your blue foam, but slightly shorter in length. Glue the grey foam onto the corners of your base and wrap it around, leaving a strip of blue foam visible in the center of ach of the four base walls.

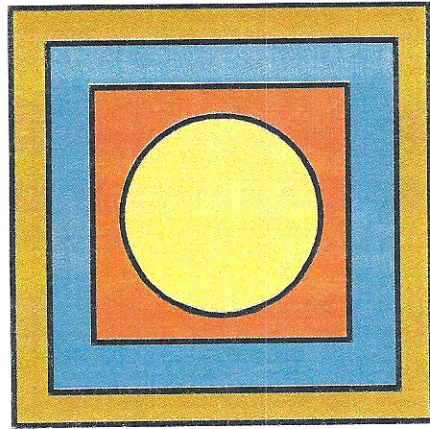
Cut a piece of orange foam into four small rectangles -each piece should fit in the top of the center blue panel on each wall. Glue them in place.

Using a blue marker, draw four small lines across the middle of each blue panel.



For the lid:

Cut three pieces of scrap foam like so:

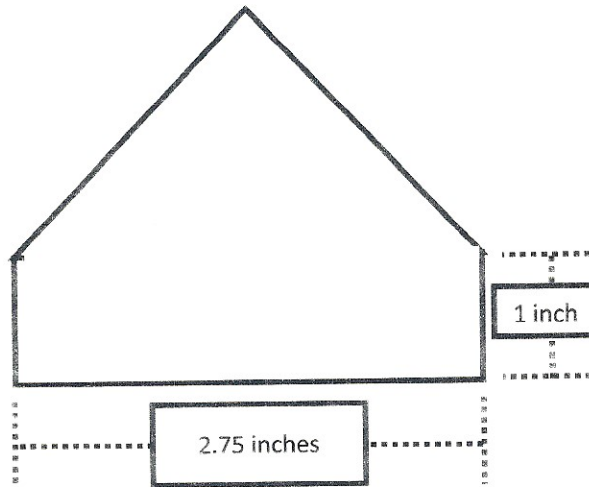


So 2 squares, 1 slightly smaller than the lid, and the other slightly smaller than the first square.

And then a smaller circle.

Glue all three pieces down onto the top of the lid.

Next, cut your white foam into 4 pieces of this shape:



Glue the rectangle section of foam to the corresponding rectangle on the lid. Then, glue the tip of the foam to the center of circle on the top of your lid. Repeat for each side.

Use hot glue to fill any cracks, and add another coat of white paint to the lid.

Last, cut a silver or grey circle and glue it to the top of your box. Feel free to draw the Overwatch symbol onto the circle.
